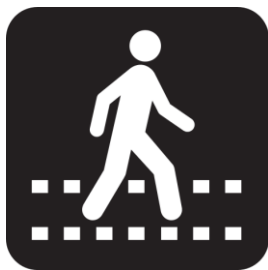


### Lunch On Line - Now Wednesday (as well as Thursday.)
