#### **School Newsletters**

Our newsletters are published once every 2 weeks on a Thursday. They are sent via email to those families who we have email addresses for, and a paper copy goes to the youngest child in each family without an email address.

Please check your emails/child's bag regularly - as it is a great way for families to keep up to date with school news, information from the teachers.

We are often asked to advertise, items from various community groups which is emailed out separately when we receive it. This is a service we provide but please note the information comes directly from each organisation / group / person and is not endorsed by the school.

#### **Student Absences**

It is very important that the school knows every child is safe and accounted for each day.

Please contact the school if your child is going to be absent - either

- text 021 104 0800.
- call 3519-407 and leave an answer-phone message before 8.30am,
- phone between 8.30am and 9.00am to personally inform the office staff,
- send a letter to school if you know in advance.

Please ensure the office has the most "Up-to-Date" contact phone numbers for you and your nominated emergency contacts - in case we need to get in touch with you.

#### LATE Arrivals.

We have a "Sign IN" system for children who arrive at school after 9.00am – when the computerised class morning roll has already been completed. Children are required to come into the office and sign in on a special form, they are then given a green "Late Pass" to take to their teacher. If your child arrives late – please remind them to go to the office to sign in before they go to their classroom. Thanks.

#### **EARLY Leavers.**

We also have a "Sign OUT" system for children who are leaving before 3.00pm. If your child / children are being collected early – the person collecting them is required to come into the office and sign out on a special form. This is to ensure we know where every child (who was at school at 9.00am in the morning) is during school each school day. Thanks.

#### **School Donation**

We will soon be sending home a separate School Donation notice. These donations allow the Board of Trustees to continue to provide a range of quality educational opportunities for our children.

#### **Assemblies**

We have a whole school assembly every Friday morning at 9.00am in the school hall. Parents and caregivers are always welcome to attend whenever they can.

Assemblies usually last approximately 40 minutes. They are designed as a positive and informative opportunity for the whole school to be together.

#### **School House Groups**

When children enrol at Burnside Primary School – they are put into a House Group (mixed from Year 1 - Year 6) BLUE - GREEN - RED - YELLOW, and throughout the year they take part in different House activities.

At the end of each year our Staff selects 8 senior students to be House Captains for the following year. The Burnside Primary School house captains are some of our school leaders. They are students who consistently show our school values, and are great people to go to if you need some help. Some of the jobs that they do are: Giving out our Fonterra milk daily, Welcoming students and families into assembly, are Captains of our sports teams, and Show visitors around our school.

#### **Annual School Photos**

Every year in Term 3 our official school photos are taken by a professional photographer. These are the whole class as well as individual students' photos. Parents have the option of purchasing either or both of their children's photos, if the wish to do so.
