#### **PB4L News**



Most of you are aware that Burnside Primary is a PB4L school. For those of you who are new to us, PB4L is short for Positive Behaviour for Learning. Hopefully you have heard already about our PB4L AKO (Aroha, Kaha, Ora) awards that children receive when they are caught demonstrating positive behaviours. These awards are collected within the teams until a certain number is reached, then the whole team receives a reward. You may have noticed school staff wearing lanyards with AKO awards attached. This is so that we are always ready to catch someone doing something worth celebrating!

Each fortnight the PB4L team contributes to the school newsletter as a way to inform you of current initiatives. This term we thought we would use this space to offer some PB4L tips that might be of use to you at home or out in the community.

**PB4L tip #1** ~ Aim to give your child at least four positive comments for every corrective one. Children learn best when they are told what they are doing right.

The photographer will also be taking Family photos – **if requested**. Please collect a 'Family' envelope from the office if you want a photo of your all children together.




## 2019 Calendar Art
