Many of our families like to send these Calendars, Cards or Diaries overseas as gifts to relatives and friends at home and abroad as gifts, especially around Christmas time.



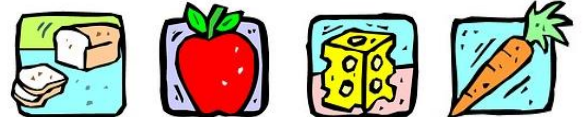
### More Food in Lunchboxes ☺ ☺

Play, Eat and Learn is where the children go out at Morning Tea and Lunch times and play first and then come back into the classroom and eat their food under the supervision of the teachers. Since the school has introduced this Play Eat Learn system we notice that many children are eating more food than before, as they are now sitting and eating – where previously they would rush out to play and forget, or not make time, to eat.

Please discuss with your children if they have enough food in their lunch boxes each day, and if not, please add another sandwich or fruit etc. We now have several children come to the office daily asking for more food as they are still hungry. Many Thanks.

### Hot Food – for Lunch

For Health & Safety reasons, the office staff are unable to cook or heat any type of food for children at lunchtime e.g. noodles, rice, dumplings, pies etc. Please give your child food that can be eaten straight from their lunch boxes – Thanks.



## School Office Hours.

Our school office opens at 8.30am every morning, and both of our office staff are usually here before then. However, please be aware that depending on how busy the morning traffic is – the office may sometimes be unattended until 8.30am. The office closes at 3.30pm every day.

## School Photographs

Class and Individual photos will be taken on - **TUESDAY 20<sup>th</sup> AUGUST. Starting at 9.00am**

**All children are asked to wear their school polo shirts – either green or white, for the photos.**

Girls – please only wear green, black or white headbands (no bright ones).

A special blue and white photo order envelope has already been sent home with every child and orders need to be returned, with payment, to the “Office Drop Box” before **9.00am on Monday 19<sup>th</sup> AUGUST.**

If possible please return these envelopes as early as possible – as the photographer is collecting them daily, so that he can sort and organise them before photo day – which means they should be returned back to school promptly.

**Please note – Our school EFTPOS cannot be used to pay for photos. Payment needs to be included in the envelope or online payment.**

Every child wanting to order must have their own ‘photo order envelope’, but they can include their payment in a brother or sister’s envelope. Payment must be made before the photo day (refunds are available, however conditions apply).

The photographer will also be taking Family photos – **if requested.** Please collect a ‘Family’ envelope from the office if you want a photo of your all children together.

## Vision & Hearing Testing

On Wednesday the Vision & Hearing Nurses were at school testing all children who were due to have their vision and hearing checked. This is done once a year for all 5 year olds, plus other children who have been absent when the testing was previously carried out. If further checks are needed children would have be given a letter to take home – please make sure you ask your child and check their school bags.

If you have any of our clothes please return to the office as soon as possible.
